

The Matthew Morrell and Natalie Sanchez Pediatric Cancer Research Fund

The Foundation, located at the University of Iowa Hospital and Clinics in Iowa City, IA, is dedicated to providing grassroots funding for the Pediatric Oncology Department to aid research for improved treatments and cures of Ewing's sarcoma and the Sarcoma Family of Tumors, as well as other pediatric cancers which may benefit from advanced research of this disease.

"No child should die from cancer. At the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics, our work is focused on identifying innovative treatments for children's cancer while causing less toxicity to patients.

The two go together. Sometimes the effects of chemotherapy can be as lethal as the disease. Support from The Matt Morrell and Natalie Sanchez Pediatric Cancer Fund has allowed us to make significant progress toward this double-edge goal of a safe, highly effective drug protocol. We're currently developing a first-of-its-kind clinical trial that tests a highly promising drug combination, but our efforts are not yet complete. So please support this fund.

All families affected by children's cancer remain hopeful for more progress, and we intend to deliver this to them. As Stephen King once wrote, "Remember, Hope is a good thing, maybe the best of things, and no good thing ever dies."

"Federal funding for pediatric cancers has dropped steadily in the past several years. The last drugs approved for treatment of Ewing's sarcoma were initiated more than 20 years ago. We must improve the pediatric cancer cure rate, as well as create better drugs and treatments.

Pediatric cancers are the least understood and researched of all cancers. Because simple measures cannot be taken to prevent pediatric cancers, and in many cases they are not inherited and cannot be screened for, these diseases receive the least funding and federal interest of all cancers."

"Matt was our son. He died in 1987 at the age of 15 from a rare bone cancer known as Ewing's sarcoma.

Natalie Sanchez was one of our grandchildren. She died in 2009 at the age of 14 from the same horrid disease. Perhaps only 200 young people contract Ewing's sarcoma in the United States each year. The disease (the result of chromosomal mutation) is not believed to be inherited, but that's one of many things that remain to be determined."

PHILTRUM PRESS

Printed by Stephen King's private Philtrum Press (Bangor, ME), these rare copies were issued to family and friends during the years 1982 – 1985 in lieu of traditional Christmas cards from the King family. THE PLANT is one of the rare Stephen King stories that has never been completed, and likely never will.

The complete set includes all three editions of THE PLANT, as well as THE EYES OF THE DRAGON. Very few complete sets were ever compiled, and ever fewer have ever surfaced. Most recipients have held onto their copies. Very rare Stephen King set.
